Our students had made poppies which were placed alongside poppies from other local schools. It was quite a special display to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Armistice Day.

All schools have received their **Planned School Based Budget Allocation Report** (SBAR) for 2019 and we are busy looking at our School Plans and students needs to determine how best to support all our students with the funding we have been given.

At this stage our anticipated 2019 enrolments are :

Kinder - 3 students, Year 1 - 4, Year 2 - 2, Year 3 - 5

Year 4 - 4 students, Year 5 - 2 and Year 6 - 6. Total 26 students.

If this number remains unchanged we will have 2 full time teachers; Mr Reeve on the K-2 class and Mrs Bell on the 3-6 class. Additional staffing is yet to be confirmed.

If anyone knows of anyone interested in enrolling student/s in Wyndham PS please ask them to contact the school as soon as possible.

Connecting Country Schools is a Government program to upgrade internet quality and access for all students in rural areas. Wyndham Public School is expecting workmen on site to carry out this upgrade next week.

Fair Discipline Policy
