We will commence work on this project at 11:30am on Thursday 6th December.

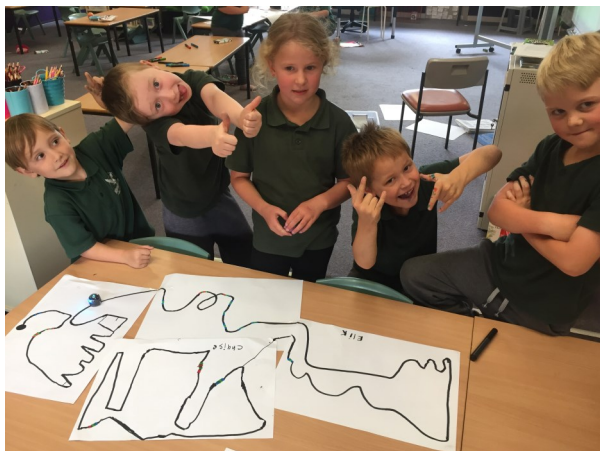
Our SAKG program will commence at 12pm as normal.

Class K—2



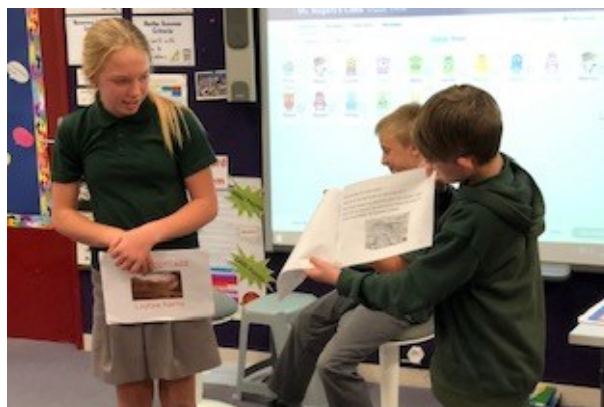
During the last few weeks our focus has shifted to writing Narratives. It has been fantastic to see some students writing Narratives at home in their spare time.
