### Attendance

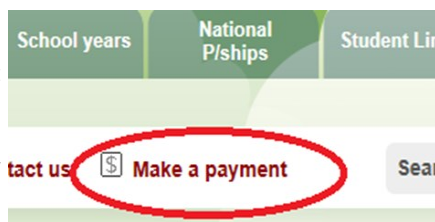
