This is a preventative based service. Currently there is no waiting list for this service.



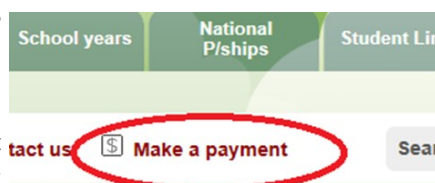

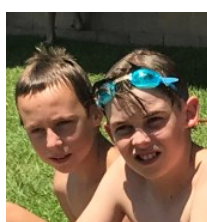
Student Insurance: Premiums are now due, it is \$5 per student which covers your child 24 hours a day 7 days a week - not just school hours.
