This Thursday our Year 3 and 5 students will be taking part in a NAPLAN online readiness test.

The school readiness test is a 'practice run' for schools to participate in a trial NAPLAN Online. The readiness test is not an assessment of student ability but allows schools to become familiar with the NAPLAN online test format and processes and provide students in NAPLAN years with the opportunity to experience the online test question types and format by completing a practice NAPLAN online test.
